

A Brief Introduction to the Tiffin Travelers Chapter of FMCA

Tiffin Travelers is an FMCA chapter, so FMCA membership is a requirement. Our members own Tiffin coaches. Most of our members hail from east of the Mississippi River, but we have members spanning the U.S. and Canada. We are not restricted by geography. We convene for fun wherever our members desire to travel. We are not directly affiliated with the "Allegro Club" or the Tiffin RV Network (TRVN), but most of our members are also members of those clubs. We welcome Tiffin owners to attend our rallies and gatherings even if they aren't members of our chapter.....yet. ; -)

Our chapter members can re-coup annual dues by saving up to \$10 per coach off rally fees at ALL of our chapter's "rallies". Join our events (Rallies and Gatherings) when you can, and we hope it is often, but attendance at events is not a requirement of membership.

Other than the Home page found at the above web link, valuable pages and subpages are: "Rallies and Gatherings"; "Newsletters"; "Meeting Minutes"; "Chapter Bylaws"; "Rally Archives and Rally Guide"; and, "Tiffin Travelers Name Badges and Clothing".

The "Newsletters" link contains the most recent club newsletter and those published in the last few years. Instead of mass mailing the newsletter, we email a notice that a recent newsletter is available for reading on the web site. No more worries that you didn't receive the news, because it stays online for you to read. Don't depend upon a reminder to look. Check the web site periodically to make sure you are in the loop. Keeping informed is on you. :-)

Rallies - Tiffin Travelers have chapter rallies several times a year in locations throughout the country. Most, but not all, of our rallies are east of the Mississippi. Rallies are organized by our members for our members, prospective members and guests. These rallies often have planned outings, dinners and other activities. Occasionally, members will organize a roaming rally to move from one point of interest to another---from state to state and/or region to region.

Gatherings - Tiffin Travelers also meet and park "together" at an event such as a national or regional Family Motor Coach Association rally. The "together" part can be tricky due to large events offering a variety of parking options (handicap, volunteer, electric, generator, etc.), but we convene for social time regardless of how our coaches might be spread about the grounds.
